January	Metropolitan Initiatives: This month will showcase organizations or collaborative initiatives that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion or borrower repayment in metropolitan areas.

March	Intellectual Disability Organizations: This month will showcase organizations who work with students with intellectual disabilities.
April	Financial Literacy or Repayment Organizations: This month will showcase organizations who work to build financial literacy or provide support to assist borrowers with student loan repayment plans.
May	Foster Student Organizations: This month will showcase organizations or collaborative initiatives that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion to foster students, including former students.
June	Adult Learners: This month will showcase organizations that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion or borrower repayment for adult learners.
July	Incarcerated Parents, Probation, Criminal Conviction Organizations: This month will showcase organizations that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion or borrower repayment for students with incarcerated parents and students with probation and criminal conviction circumstances.
August	Homeless Organizations: This month will showcase organizations that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion for students who are homeless.
September	First Generation Organizations: This month will showcase organizations that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion or borrower repayment for first generation students.
October	Statewide Initiative: This month will showcase organizations or collaborative initiatives that aim to provide information, support, and/or increase on FAFSA completion or borrower repayment in the state.
