0% interest ends, and payments will begin in October.

Find your loan servicer here: studentaid.gov/manage-loans/r...

Q: When will student loan interest start accruing?

A: Student loan interest will resume on **Sept. 1, 2023**. For most borrowers, your interest rate will be the same as it was before the 0% interest began. Some borrowers will find their interest rate has changed. For example, your interest rate may have changed if you consolidated your loans during the payment pause. **Log in to your loan servicer's website to learn about your interest rate.**
